DRIVE-IN WORSHIP This worship continues to bless participants with fellowship, community, and sacrament. We have two more Saturday worships scheduled at 4:30 p.m., before we start the next phase of our coming together. Worship Life, Pastor, and Council continue to explore ways to make worship as inclusive, meaningful, and uplifting as possible. Your suggestions are welcome as we move forward. Please allow us the benefit of your creativity as we move into the regular church calendar.

SUNDAY WORSHIP Our recent council meeting resulted in a move toward 'normalcy'. We have decided to start hosting worship in the parking lot on Sunday mornings. As is true with most of our 'returns to normal', this will be a hybrid of safe social distancing, hopefully under a tent, as well as distancing by remaining in your vehicle. Our plan is to distribute pre-packaged communion elements, having those who wish to be outdoors bring chairs, using the FM broadcast for those who wish to stay safely in their cars. The recorded songs will be played, the readings shared, the sermon presented, and Holy Communion observed. We are looking at a September 13th start date.
